1 Proceedings 2 3 CHAIRMAN PURCELL: Okay. Before we get 4 tonight's meeting going, actually, just two 5 things we're going to do. One, we're going б to start with tonight's public hearing is 7 going to be adjourned for 111 Liberty, and 8 our attorney will explain why. 9 MR. HONAN: Good evening, everyone. My 10 name is Steve Honan. I'm the attorney 11 advising the Board. 12 We recently received a letter from the 13 attorney for the applicant 111 South Liberty. 14 And what he has requested is an adjournment 15 of the public hearing until our September 16 meeting. So I thank you for coming out 17 tonight, but we will not be continuing the 18 public hearing tonight and taking comments 19 from the public. But that will take place at 20 our next scheduled meeting in September, 21 which is -- does anyone know what the date 2.2 is? 23 CHAIRMAN PURCELL: 28th. 24 MR. HONAN: September 28. So that's 25 next month. So if you came out, I'm sorry,

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2	but we will not be hearing that application
3	tonight at the request of the attorney for
4	the applicant. Yes, sir.
5	MR. JULIAN: I would like to invite the
б	people who came for that hearing to meet next
7	door at the lounge. We have a room that we
8	rented. We're going to discuss what citizens
9	can do.
10	And not to contest the Planning Board,
11	but to give the Planning Board an option and
12	tell them through our work and findings we
13	believe that they can stop this building.
14	And we're going to give suggestions of why we
15	think they have to do that. And there's been
16	a lot of talk, fear of the Planning Board
17	being, facing litigation if the business
18	developer doesn't get his way. Well, I think
19	we have to discuss a Article 78 if the
20	citizens don't get their way.
21	So that's what we're going to do. We're
22	not contesting. We're going to give our
23	findings to the Planning Board. But we're
24	pretty convinced that this building, as it
25	stands today, will not meet the Zoning or

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2	Planning Board codes. So we're going to meet
3	right outside and in front of Patriot Lounge.
4	Thank you.
5	MR. HONAN: Okay, sir, and that's fine
6	if you meet outside. I also encourage you,
7	if you have any comments for this Board, you
8	can put them in writing and submit them to
9	the Board so that we can consider them and
10	the applicant can consider them. But as of
11	right now, we really cannot discuss the
12	particulars of this application because the
13	applicant is not here.
14	CHAIRMAN PURCELL: And you can still
15	continue to submit, like our attorney said,
16	to the clerk. Excuse me, secretary of the
17	Planning Board, Mary. You can still submit
18	things, so.
19	So I just also, I got to address
20	something real quick. George, just to let
21	you know, going forward, this was a
22	resolution by the Town Board about
23	designating a photography area, video and
24	media. The Town passed a resolution about
25	it. So if you were to take video, recording

So if you could, 5 George, if you're going to record or б whatever, if you could just please move over 7 to the area. We really appreciate it. So, yes, ma'am. 8 9 MS. JESSIE: I just wanted to know when 10 the --11 CHAIRMAN PURCELL: Hold on a second. 12 George, I asked very kindly. 13 MR. POTANOVIC: I'm doing it from my 14 seat. 15 CHAIRMAN PURCELL: George, you're 16 recording. I'm not here to --17 MR. POTANOVIC: I'm recording from my 18 seat. 19 CHAIRMAN PURCELL: George, the Town 20 Board passed a resolution. 21 MR. POTANOVIC: When did they pass a 22 resolution? I was at the last --23 CHAIRMAN PURCELL: Resolution was passed 24 on August 8th at 7:00 p.m., 2023. Protocol, 25 concerning protocol for video recordings or

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2	photography used during Town Hall meetings.
3	So I'm not don't kill the messenger here.
4	I'm just relaying the message from the Town
5	Board. I'm asking very nice and
6	professionally if you could please have
7	yourself into the area that's been designated
8	by the Town Board to do your recordings.
9	MR. POTANOVIC: Okay.
10	CHAIRMAN PURCELL: Please, George.
11	That's all I'm asking, George, nicely.
12	MR. HONAN: George, if you could please
13	remove yourself from that area. You're
14	blocking the fire door. It's not permitted
15	for anyone to be seated in that area while we
16	have occupancy in the room.
17	MR. POTANOVIC: There were seats here.
18	MR. HONAN: Well, you see they're
19	moveable and
20	CHAIRMAN PURCELL: George, again, I'm
21	asking nicely. I appreciate it. I think
