We're adding an existing lot 9 with an existing single-family dwelling. 10 applicant would like to subdivide the lot and 11 provide a house on North Street. A 12 subdivision is in conformance with all the 13 zoning codes. Tonight is our first public 14 hearing. If you remember, this is at the 8 end of the road. It's a little rough. 9 CHAIRMAN JOHNSON: Yeah. 10 MR. O'ROURKE: So that's still 11 outstanding. 12 CHAIRMAN JOHNSON: All right. So I think one 14 of my concerns is what, are they going to 15 knock that house down and then put two 16 significantly redesigned houses there? Or 17 just going to use the back lot to create the 18 new house? 19 CHAIRMAN JOHNSON: I believe the front 20 house on Grassy Point is going to remain. 21 No, no -- not going to be affected at all by 22 this project. They're just going to divide 23 the lot and build a second house on the back 24 side of the lot there.

MR. BLACK: And also, they're

## 1 Proceedings 2 environmentally sensitive that, you know, 3 high water tables, wetlands to be designated 4 for it too, so. I'm new to this but, you 5 know, I'd just like to have some input or 6 understand what the community that we live 7 in, you know. 8 CHAIRMAN JOHNSON: Our consultants are 9 all over that. If anybody -- John, would you 10 like --MR. O'ROURKE: Yeah, if you want me to 11 12 speak to that, yeah. We were concerned with 13 this property because it is in a flood zone. It is near the sewer treatment plant. 14 15 does have a high ground water table. 16 So the applicant over the last several 17 months has been modifying his design. 18 submitted a flood elevation. The house in 19 the second lot is going to be raised. 20 Parking underneath it. And there's going to 21 be stormwater chambers to collect the 22 stormwater from the new house actually in the

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ground and then slowly release it afterwards.

So he has been -- we've been commenting, he's

been addressing, so.
