

Town of Stony Point, New York**

Dear Mr. Beckmann:

Hudson Geographic LLC has prepared the following proposal to assist the Town of Stony Point with slope analysis. The following services and fees are outlined below:

I. Services – Scope of Work. Generate slope as a percent values for tax parcels within the Town of Stony Point and develop a GIS Slope Analysis Tool.

1. Develop methods to generate slope by percent per tax parcel for both USGS DEM, and RCGIS topology data.
2. Present results and a summary of methods to Town of Stony Point Assessor.
3. Revise methods as necessary and finalize slope by percent per tax parcel data generation.
4. Develop GIS Slope Analysis Tool to standardize and automate future slope analysis.
5. Recommend software needed by Stony Point to utilize the GIS Slope Analysis Tool.
6. Train staff to use the GIS Slope Analysis Tool.

II. Fee Schedule.

1. Analyst: \$100/ hour.
2. Application Development and Cartography: \$125/ hour.
3. Project Management: \$150/ hour.

II. Estimated Cost Proposal.

1. Analyst – 20 Hours Data collection, method development, slope data development.
2. Application Development – 20 Hours GIS Slope Analysis Tool development.
3. Meetings – 5 Hours Project Management.

Total estimated cost: \$5,250.

Final costs will be based on actual hours performed for the above services. Invoices will be submitted monthly and are due upon receipt.
