

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
TOWN PICKLE BALL COURT CONSTRUCTION**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that sealed proposals will be received by the Town of Stony Point Town Clerk at Town Hall located at 74 East Main Street, Stony Point, New York until 10AM local time on March 21, 2024 for "TOWN PICKLE BALL COURT CONSTRUCTION" and then at said office, publicly opened and read aloud.

SCOPE OF WORK: The work consists of providing all labor and equipment for the construction of two pickle ball courts as well as associated fencing, parking and walkways, as well as an alternative bid for two additional courts.

Information for Bidders, Specifications, and Contract Documents for the proposed work are on file and can be reviewed and copy obtained from the Town Clerk's Office in Town of Stony Point Town Hall located at 74 E. Main Street, Stony Point, New York between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday beginning February 8, 2024 and concluding at March 21, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. Documents may be obtained via **electronic means** at NO charge by contacting the Town Clerk at (845) 786-2716 or mcarey@townofstonypoint.org.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at 10:00 a.m. on March 6, 2024 at Veterans Memorial Park located on Turkey Hollow Road, Stony Point, New York 10980.

All bidders are required to familiarize themselves with the existing conditions and proposed improvements prior to submitting the sealed proposal in accordance with this Advertisement for Bids.

This project is being funded in whole or in part by the Rockland County's Urban Green Space Grant Program with Federal funds obtained through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). All federal grant requirements will apply to the contract. Prevailing wages established under the Davis-Bacon Act will apply to this contract. All bidders will need to sign and notarize that they agree to this and other applicable requirements for the expenditure of Federal funds in the Federal Clauses Form included with bid documents.

A Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) must be obtained and provided at the time of bid. The bidder's SAM.gov profile must be public facing. Prior to contract, the bidder must uphold a complete, active registration with SAM.gov. Contracts cannot be signed without an active registration with SAM.gov. The ARPA Department can provide a SAM.gov Registration Guide upon request. All vendors, contractors/subcontractors, consultants/subconsultants, etc., must be registered in the Federal SAM as well as the prime consultant/contractor and must have the standing to receive federal awards. Unless excepted by 2 CFR 25.110(b) or (c), or has an exception approved by the federal awarding agency under 2 CFR 25.110(d) they are required to be fully registered in SAM.gov; provide a valid unique entity identifier; and continue to maintain an active SAM.gov registration with current information, at all times during the period of performance.

The Town of Stony Point reserves the right to reject any and all bids and/or to accept any proposal which meets the criteria herein and in the opinion of the Town of Stony Point is in the best interest of the residents of the Town of Stony Point.

All bidders must be licensed to do business within the State of New York. Out-of-state bidders must be registered with the Secretary of State.

Submissions from all bidders are required to contain a certification of non-collusion bidding pursuant to Section 103d of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York.
