SUMMARY OF BOND RESOLUTION

Set forth below is a summary of said resolution adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Stony Point, Rockland County, New York, on February 27, 2024.

1. The resolution is entitled “BOND RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF STONY POINT, ROCKLAND COUNTY, NEW YORK (THE “TOWN”), AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF TWO REPLACEMENT POLICE VEHICLES FOR USE BY THE TOWN; STATING THE MAXIMUM ESTIMATED COST THEREOF IS \$126,000; APPROPRIATING SAID AMOUNT THEREFOR; AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF UP TO \$126,000 IN SERIAL BONDS OF THE TOWN TO FINANCE SAID APPROPRIATION”.

2. Amount of Debt Obligations Authorized: \$126,000.

3. The resolution authorized serial bonds of the Town to finance the acquisition of two police vehicles for use by the Town’s Police Department and any appurtenant and incidental costs and expenses related to the foregoing.

4. Period of Probable Usefulness: 3 years.
