SUMMARY OF BOND RESOLUTION 2017-7

Set forth below is a summary of said resolution adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Stony Point on March 28, 2017.

- 1. The resolution is entitled "BOND RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF STONY POINT, ROCKLAND COUNTY, NEW YORK (THE "TOWN"), AUTHORIZING THE RECONSTRUCTION AND REPAVING OF ROADS THROUGHOUT THE TOWN AND THE ACQUISITION OF ONE PLOW TRUCK; STATING THE MAXIMUM ESTIMATED COST THEREOF IS \$575,000; APPROPRIATING SAID AMOUNT THEREFOR; AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF UP TO \$575,000 IN SERIAL BONDS OF THE TOWN TO FINANCE SAID APPROPRIATION".
- 2. <u>Object or Purpose</u>: (i) the reconstruction and repaving of roads throughout the Town, including, as necessary or appropriate, the construction or reconstruction of sidewalks, curbs, gutters, drainage, landscaping, and grading or improving right of way improvements in connection therewith and (ii) the acquisition of one plow truck for use by the Town's Highway Department, and any appurtenant and incidental costs and expenses to each of the foregoing.
 - 3. <u>Period of Probable Usefulness</u>: 15 years.
 - 4. <u>Amount of Debt Obligations Authorized</u>: \$575,000.
