Patriot Paws Dog Park Rules and Regulations

Patriot Paws is a dog park where people and their dogs can play together. It offers an off-leash area where dogs can also run and play with others. Patriot Paws is open to only Town of Stony Point residents and non-residents who obtain a dog park use permit from the Town Clerk's Office. **Patriot Paws** is an "enter at your own risk" facility. Dog owners are absolutely responsible and liable for the actions and behavior of their dogs at all times. The liability waiver and registration included in this form must be filled out and signed for a permit to be granted by the Town for use of the park.

- Proof of all shots and current Town dog license must be shown at time of registration. An annual fee also must be paid at time of registration.
- Annual fees for one (1) dog are: \$15.00 for Town of Stony Point Residents and \$30.00 for Non-Residents.
- There will be a \$5.00 charge for each additional dog per owner.
- Annual fees cover the calendar year for which they are issued and can be paid at the Town Clerk's Office at 74 East Main Street, Stony Point.

Patriot Paws Etiquette and Rules

Once you and your dog enter the park, it's tempting to stand back and watch all the activity. However, everyone will have a more rewarding experience if you observe some basic etiquette during your visit to the dog park. Please be courteous to other dog owners and ensure that your dog is getting along with the other dogs in the park. The following rules must be observed at all times. Anyone not following park rules will risk removal from the park and suspension of their permit. **The key to the success of Patriot Paws is YOU.**

Please read each of the following rules and INITIAL:

1. The park is open from 7am – Dusk daily. It will be closed during the winter months. _____
2. All dogs must be kept on a leash at all times except in the designated "off-leash" area. This means that the dogs must be on a leash while walking to and from the park. Any dog off leash outside the park can be cited for dog running at large pursuant to the Town of Stony Point Town Code 61-3 D (1). _____
3. "Off-Leash" dogs must be under voice control of their owner at all times. If voice control is not possible, do not enter the "Off Leash" areas. _____
4. Dog owners must have the leash in hand at all times. In the event of problems, dog owners should quickly leash and remove their dog from the park. _____
5. No children under 10 are allowed in the park unless accompanied by an adult. Children MUST be closely supervised by an adult and must behave appropriately: no running, shouting, climbing on agility equipment, chasing dogs or petting other dogs without the owner's permission. _____
6. Owners must clean up and dispose of feces left by your dog using the receptacles provided. _____
7. Owners should fill any holes your dog may dig. _____
8. Limit of only 2 dogs per adult, per visit. _____

9. The park is open from 7am to dusk _____
10. All dogs must be licensed, current on vaccines, healthy and parasite-free. _____
11. All dogs must wear a collar with its current, Town-issued dog license. In addition, your permit card must be kept with you while at the park. You may at any time be asked to show this to a Park attendant, Police Officer, Animal Control Officer and/or Ordinance Officer. _____
12. Dog must be kept in sight and not left unattended. _____
13. Females in heat and puppies under 4 months of age are absolutely PROHIBITED. Spayed and neutered animals are recommended. _____
14. No aggressive dogs are allowed. Immediately leash your dog and leave the park if any aggressive behavior is observed. _____
15. No food or treats of any kind (Human or Dog) are permitted within any fenced area, parking lot or areas adjacent to the park. _____
16. Owners will take care to close all park gates after entering or exiting. _____
17. No outside toys, raw hides or bones are allowed in park. _____
18. No smoking is permitted in the park. _____
19. Owner must clean up after their dogs. _____
20. No brushing or grooming of pets inside the park. _____

Waiver and Release of Liability and Assumption of Risk

Acknowledgement:

I (we) agree to hold the Town of Stony Point, their members, directors, officers, agents, volunteers and employees harmless from any claim for loss or injury that may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of other persons, owners, guardians and/or their dog(s) while in or upon the grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of our dog(s) by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to our dog(s), whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of Town of Stony Point or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes. Risks may include, but are not limited to, injury or damage caused directly or indirectly as a result of dog fights, dog bites, being knocked-down, chased or tripped, dog(s) being hit by a motor vehicle, etc.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless of this unsupervised facility from any and all loss and expense (including legal and expert witness fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in the use of Patriot Paws Dog Park, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property or persons may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties, or agents, or any other persons. I agree to carefully inspect and approve for myself (ourselves) that the facilities provided are safe for their intended use. Once having conducted the inspection, I (we) agree to expressly assume all risks for myself, guardians, my children and my dog(s) participating at these premises.

By my signature below, I state that I (we): 1) agree to the terms and conditions described herein, 2) have read and fully understand the Patriot Paws Dog Park Rules and Regulations (and will explain the same to attending children and guests), and 3) agree to comply fully with all of the conditions of the Patriot Paws Dog Park use. I (we) understand that violation of these terms, conditions, rules and regulations may result in suspension or revocation of the Patriot Paws Dog Park privileges, I (we) also agree to immediately report any unsafe property conditions to the Town of Stony Point.
