

NOTICE OF ANNUAL ELECTION
STONY POINT FIRE DISTRICT

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Annual Election of the Stony Point Fire District will take place on December 11, 2018 between the hours of 6:00 P.M. and 9:00 P.M. at the firehouse located at 25 North Liberty Drive (Route 9W), Stony Point, New York for the following purposes:

To elect one (1) Fire District Commissioner for a five (5) year term commencing January 1, 2019 and ending December 31, 2023; and

To vote upon the following proposition:

Shall the Board Resolution entitled:

“RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS OF THE STONY POINT FIRE DISTRICT, ADOPTED OCTOBER 25, 2018 AUTHORIZING THE AMENDMENT OF THE STONY POINT FIRE DISTRICT DEFINED BENEFIT SERVICE AWARD PROGRAM HERETOFORE ESTABLISHED TO: 1) INCREASE THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF YEARS OF SERVICE CREDIT AN ACTIVE FIREFIGHTER MAY EARN UNDER THE SERVICE AWARD PROGRAM POINT SYSTEM FROM 35 TO 40. THE ANNUAL COST OF THE CURRENT PROGRAM PAYABLE BY THE FIRE DISTRICT IN 2019 IS ESTIMATED TO BE AS MUCH AS TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND AND 00/100 (\$200,000.00) DOLLARS, OR ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED NINETY AND 00/100 (\$1,590.00) DOLLARS PER COVERED PARTICIPANT WITH AN ANNUAL ADMINISTRATIVE COST OF SEVEN THOUSAND AND 00/100 (\$7,000.00) DOLLARS. THE CALENDAR YEAR 2019 ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST OF THE AMENDED PROGRAM MAY BE AS MUCH AS TWO HUNDRED THIRTEEN THOUSAND AND 00/100 (\$213,000.00) DOLLARS, OR ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED NINETY AND 00/100 (\$1,690.00) DOLLARS PER COVERED PARTICIPANT WITH NO INCREASE IN THE ANNUAL ADMINISTRATIVE COST AND STATING THAT THE FAILURE OF THE AMENDMENT TO BE APPROVED BY THE VOTERS OF THE STONY POINT FIRE DISTRICT WILL IN NO WAY AFFECT THE PROVISIONS OF THE SERVICE AWARD PROGRAM PRESENTLY IN EFFECT.”

BE APPROVED?

All residents of the Stony Point Fire District, who are duly registered to vote with the Rockland County Board of Elections on or before November 19, 2018 shall be entitled to vote at this election.

Any person desiring to have his or her name appear on the ballot for the above office must have filed a written request with the Secretary of the Fire District not later than November 21, 2018.
