Station. 7 site plan is located on the south corner of 8 North Liberty Drive and Route 9W, and Summit 9 It's a new application. Mr. Zigler? Avenue.

MR. ZIGLER: All right, Dave Zigler from Atzl, Nasher and Zigler. And to my right is supposed to be George Thamsen, but I don't see him.

Basically up on the screen you have a layout of the Stony Point firehouse. It's on 9W. So if you're standing in 9W and you're looking at the firehouse, on your left is a sign today. And they're going to replace that sign with a new LED sign that the firehouse, and the ambulance, and I think the police are allowed to put in, they're the only ones.

But being that that site is so old, there was no map. So we just created this plot plan map. And we show the sign on it.

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The new sign is in red. And it's really in the same location as the existing sign, back to back. So the existing sign is too close to the right of way. The new sign will be directly behind it. And it will be legal from the right of way.

We won't have a problem with blocking the view down, up and down the street. It will be set back farther from the actual pavement. And the dimensions meet the code.

And that's about it. It's just really a sign location site plan. That's it. There's no other proposal, no paving, no curbs, no new firehouse. Just a new sign.

CHAIRMAN GUBITOSA: Just a new sign.

Max, any comments on this one?

MR. STACH: Yeah, so technically on this application, since it doesn't fit any descriptions of a Type Two action, you do have to meet the requirements of SEQRA, even though this is really just the minimum change to the site. In this instance, I provided you tonight with a Part 2 indicating no potential impacts, and a negative declaration

4 1 Proceedings 2 for your use. 3 However, I think it's good to know for 4 the record that there were two omissions on 5 the EAF Part 1 provided by the applicant. 6 The first is that this is in a area of 7 potential archaeological resources. And this 8 would actually receive a hit for endangered 9 and threatened species. Both of these things aren't uncommon in this area. We know 10 11 generally what they are. This is within 12 range of the same eagles that were being 13 discussed at the waterfront location. 14 most of Stony Point is actually in an 15 archaeologically significant area. 16 In this case, the actual sign 17 installation would not have any impact on 18 those resources.
