CHAIRMAN GUBITOSA: Next is Nine Holt Drive. There's a site plan located on the south side of Holt Drive, 588 feet east of South Liberty Drive. It's a new application.

MR. ZIGLER: Dave Zigler from Atzl, Nasher and Zigler. And we actually had an application in earlier, about three months ago, and the building was too big. And we were playing around with the building.

So we revised the application. And we're building -- it bears the same thing as before, but it's a little bit smaller to meet the code. So instead of being 30,000 , it's about 28,000. And in the front of the building is a commercial aspect of the building.

So what we're done here is we kind of made a sister building. So he can either split it and have a renter in the front and the back, or if he has one renter, he can take the whole building.

Mary went and circulated the maps, but I would ask to have them recirculated again

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because for some reason, people called me and they didn't get the map. They only got the building. So I would ask the Board to recirculate. And I think recirculating -you circulated for lead agency.

I'd ask to have that recirculated because for some reason, the people only got the building. And I sent it out, but they didn't have time to respond. So I think if you just resent it, the total practice would be better.

So the building itself is going to replace the existing one that's out there. And it's going to sit in the north-south direction. The parking is going to be on the left side, that would be the east side. And then you're going to have two truck docks dead center in the middle of the building. That's why it has the indentation there. We have plenty of parking. We meet the bulk requirements for the yards.

And the next step in this process would be a landscaping and drainage, and that's going to be pretty much the same as

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Vesco (ph). We'll have the same kind of drainage system with something in the parking lot. And as far as the landscaping, we'll go with the accepted trees that you did out front, and then buffering in the back.

So I'd ask at this time if you just recirculate the maps, and then we'll make a full submission next month with the drainage calculations and everything. And then we'll ask for a public hearing. Also at that time, we would ask to go to the ARB.

CHAIRMAN GUBITOSA: Is this the building
to the right of the piano guy?
BOARD MEMBER FERGUSON: Yes.
MR. ZIGLER: Looking at the piano guy, yes. It's actually the second building going down the road, right.

CHAIRMAN GUBITOSA: So if I'm, like, at Shop Rite --

BOARD MEMBER ROGERS: It's right there as you come out.

MR. ZIGLER: If you come out the far end --

CHAIRMAN GUBITOSA: The far entrance,

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he's that way.
MR. ZIGLER: Kind of catty-corner, yes.
CHAIRMAN GUBITOSA: Okay.

MR. ZIGLER: Yes. Right now, it's a little building on a big lot. This proposal changes that. He has a couple people interested. One of them is the baker that's down at the other end by the tunnel. He's outgrown that building. So there is interest. And if it's that tenant, he might take the whole building.

CHAIRMAN GUBITOSA: All right. So you
just want us to recirculate the maps?
MR. ZIGLER: Yeah. And then we'll submit a total package with the drainage, the landscaping, and then the building. And we'll have colored renderings of the building, of the sheet that some people got and some people didn't.

CHAIRMAN GUBITOSA: All right.
MR. ZIGLER: And then ask for a public hearing next month.

BOARD MEMBER KRAESE: So we're looking at a hundred feet wide by about 325,324 feet

MR. ZIGLER: Yeah.
BOARD MEMBER KRAESE: Okay.
MR. ZIGLER: It's -- the only thing
different is this is a little bit wider than this. But the total length I think is 280-something. 300 foot. Total length is 300 foot. That's where we lost the extra footage to meet the code.

BOARD MEMBER KRAESE: Oh, I got you now.
CHAIRMAN GUBITOSA: Max?
MR. STACH: To clarify, you said
recirculate for lead agency.
MR. ZIGLER: Yeah, I --
MR. STACH: We can do a -- did we do a coordinated review last time?

MR. ZIGLER: I don't know. It was circulated, and the County called me for some reason. I thought maybe you did it for --

MR. STACH: I don't think -- we didn't do a, I don't think we did a notice of intent to be lead agency. Because I can't think of any other approvals you required.

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MR. ZIGLER: I just had people calling me that got it. And you know, like

Haverstraw being adjacent, I don't know what
plans they got. So let me just -- whatever
you circulated it under, we should
recirculate it.
MR. STACH: I would say for tonight, I
think it makes sense for you to declare
yourselves lead agency. This is a
significantly different -- you didn't get too
far last time.
MR. ZIGLER: No.
CHAIRMAN GUBITOSA: All right. I need a motion to be lead agency.

BOARD MEMBER FERGUSON: I'll make a motion.

BOARD MEMBER ROGERS: I'll second.
CHAIRMAN GUBITOSA: All right, motion, second. All in favor?
(Response of aye was given.)
CHAIRMAN GUBITOSA: All right. We're going to be lead agency.

MR. ZIGLER: And I think what happened was when we submitted, we put the two maps

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back to back, not inside, because one was the
site plan and one was the building. And
that's how I think they got separated. We'll
straighten that out to make sure. When Mary
comes back, I'll make sure she has a set
stapled together.
    CHAIRMAN GUBITOSA: Bill, anything, any
comments on this, or wait until the --
    MR. SHEEHAN: No, I got to take a look
at them.
    CHAIRMAN GUBITOSA: All right, thank
you, Bill. All right, we'll see you at the
TAC meeting.
