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CHAIRMAN GUBITOSA: Next is Nine Holt Drive. There's a site plan located on the south side of Holt Drive, 588 feet east of South Liberty Drive. It's a new application.

MR. ZIGLER: Dave Zigler from Atzl,
Nasher and Zigler. And we actually had an
application in earlier, about three months
ago, and the building was too big. And we
were playing around with the building.

So we revised the application. And we're building -- it bears the same thing as before, but it's a little bit smaller to meet the code. So instead of being 30,000, it's about 28,000. And in the front of the building is a commercial aspect of the building.

So what we're done here is we kind of made a sister building. So he can either split it and have a renter in the front and the back, or if he has one renter, he can take the whole building.

Mary went and circulated the maps, but I would ask to have them recirculated again

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| 2 | because for some reason, people called me and |
| 3 | they didn't get the map. They only got the |
| 4 | building. So I would ask the Board to |
| 5 | recirculate. And I think recirculating |
| 6 | you circulated for lead agency. |

And the next step in this process would be a landscaping and drainage, and that's going to be pretty much the same as

And as far as the landscaping, we'll go 5 with the accepted trees that you did out 6 front, and then buffering in the back. 7 So I'd ask at this time if you just 8 recirculate the maps, and then we'll make a 9 full submission next month with the drainage 10 calculations and everything. And then we'll 11 ask for a public hearing. Also at that time, 12 we would ask to go to the ARB. 13 CHAIRMAN GUBITOSA: Is this the building 14 to the right of the piano guy? 15 BOARD MEMBER FERGUSON: Yes. 16 MR. ZIGLER: Looking at the piano guy, 17 yes. It's actually the second building going 18 down the road, right. 19 CHAIRMAN GUBITOSA: So if I'm, like, at 20 Shop Rite --21 BOARD MEMBER ROGERS: It's right there 2.2 as you come out. 23 MR. ZIGLER: If you come out the far 24 end --25 CHAIRMAN GUBITOSA: The far entrance,
