STONY POINT TOWN BOARD MEETING - March 26, 2024

The Town Board of the Town of Stony Point convened in Regular Session on Tuesday, March 26, 2024 at 7:00 pm at the Stony Point Community Center, 19 Clubhouse Lane, Stony Point, NY. Before starting the meeting Supervisor Monaghan asked for a moment of silence in honor of NYPD Police Office Jonathan Diller. Officer Diller was shot and killed in the line of duty by a career criminal during a routine traffic stop, leaving behind his wife and one year old son. Supervisor Monaghan opened the meeting in memory of John Kryger. Mr. Kryger spent a lifetime of service to the community. He was a retired FDNY, Dep. Fire Coordinator for Rockland and County Fire Instructor among many other services. His son Andrew is a Stony Point Police Department Detective and head of the Stony Point PAL. Supervisor Monaghan called the meeting to order and led the group in the pledge of allegiance.
