SUPERVISOR'S REPORT

<u>Supervisor Monaghan</u> stated that June 25, 2021, Chief Brian Moore will be retiring after 41 years of service with the Stony Point Police Department and introduce Chief Moore.

<u>Chief Moore</u> read the following statement:

"Please accept this memorandum as notification of my intention to retire from Town service, as Chief of Police of the Stony Point Police Department on June 26, 2021. It has been my honor and privilege to have served this Town for the past 41 ½ years. Although this moment is bittersweet, I leave knowing this Department and my officers are well-equipped to handle any challenges that lie ahead. I count myself fortunate to have served with and under some of the finest officers, who have always been committed to providing the very best service to the residents of this community. On a personal level, I realize no person rises to a position of leadership without the hard work and the assistance of those they have served with. To all of you I say thank you for your support and salute you on a job well done.

I would like to recognize and thank our residents who have always supported the Stony Point Police Department and showed their appreciation for our services. Stony Point was, is and will always be the finest Town because of our people. Thank you for your help, support, kindness and friendship these past 41 years.

Lastly, I would like to take the opportunity to thank the members of the current Town Board, past Town Boards and Police Commissions, for their support and confidence in my ability to provide the services this community so richly deserves. These past 10 years as Chief have gone by quickly with the ever-changing landscape facing law enforcement. I believe we will continue to adapt and overcome any challenges. The Stony Point Police Department is built on a solid foundation of the finest officers able to face, head on, any changes or needs for this community's safety that lie ahead.

This has truly been a rewarding career and I am eternally grateful for the opportunity. I wish you all the very best in the future."

WHEREAS Brian Moore will retire from the town of Stony Point Police Department on June 25, 2021 with 41 years of faithful service. Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED that I, Jim Monaghan, as Supervisor and acting on behalf of the Town Board and the grateful citizens of the Town of Stony Point wish to express our gratitude and appreciation to Brian Moore for his many years of dedicated service and do hereby declare his last day of service, June 25, 2021, as "Chief Brian Moore Day" in the Town of Stony Point.
